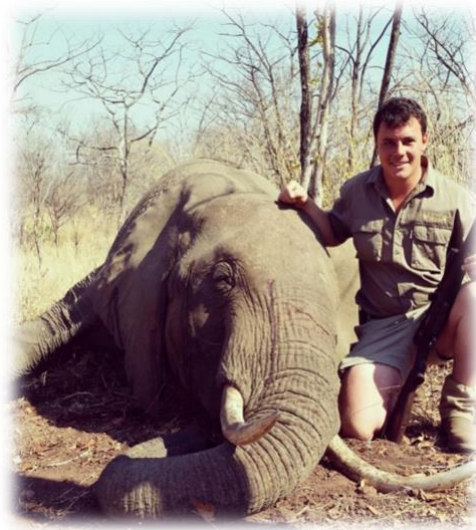
ABOUT US

Stefi-Joe Deep Sea Fishing at Sodwana Bay or Richards Bay KwaZulu-Natal

Minimum of 5 days / Minimum of 2 persons

If weather permitted and we can go fishing: \$500 per day per person

The day that we can't go fishing due to weather : \$350 per person per day

- We offer deep-sea fishing on a 21ft boat named "STEFI-JOE"
- Boats are well equipped for bill- and game- fishing and the captains/skippers are very experienced.
- Registered for five anglers and skipper.
- The boat Launch from Sodwana Bay Beach or Richards Bay.
- Launch time in summer – November to April – 6h00 – 14h00. (weather permitting).
- Launch time in winter – May to October – 7h00 – 14h00. (weather permitting).
- We supply all fishing equipment, snacks and soft drinks on the boat, for the day.
- Deep-sea Trolling.

NB: The day that we can't go fishing there is lots to do : Game reserve , Crocodile Park , Leopard & Cheetah Park

Sodwana Bay is one of the world's top dive and fishing sites. The world's southern-most coral reefs harbour over 1200 species of Coral Fish, Rays, Eels and Turtles while Whale sharks, Dolphins, Sharks and Whales are common visitors. The Raggie Sharks and Turtles are popular guests in the summer.

Richards Bay is a town situated on a 30 square kilometre lagoon of the [Mhlatuze River](#), which gives it one of the country's largest [harbours](#) and in one of the richest wildlife areas of [KwaZulu-Natal](#), South Africa, with numerous 5 star game lodges and wildlife attractions a short drive away. Not only can one view the big 5 on land, but one can catch the big six at sea too!! (Blue Marlin, Black Marlin, Striped Marlin, Sailfish, Spearfish and Broadbill Swordfish) Not to mention all the other game fish species that frequent its shores.

Clients are advised to take out the necessary insurance to cover the possibility of any accident or loss! Lloyd safaris have no connections to the air charter companies that transport our guests and shall not be held liable for any delay or loss of hunting days due to luggage or weapons being delayed or lost en-route! We are also not responsible for delays/results due to bad weather!

GENERAL:

- All conditions on our website apply. See www.lloyd-safaris.co.za
- Lloyd Safaris reserve the right to change any price prior to any agreement.
- Lloyd Safaris reserve the right to change any hunting venue should the need arise.
- 50% deposit of the daily rate must be paid upon booking a hunt. The final 50% of the daily rate must be paid 60 days prior to arrival.
- All outstanding fees must be paid prior to departure.
- All wounded animals must be paid for in full. The decision of the Outfitter and PH whether an animal was wounded or not is final.
- The PH has a legal responsibility to ensure that wounded animals are killed in a humane manner and to ensure that no animal suffers unnecessarily and reserve the right to step in to kill such animal should the situation require it.
- A contract must be signed between Lloyd Safaris and the client prior to payment of the 50% deposit.
- Should a Safari that was already booked and paid for be cancelled for whatever reason, then Lloyd Safaris reserve the right to withhold any payment already made for expenses incurred. Clients are advised to take out insurance to cover any such eventualities.

HOW TO BOOK YOUR SAFARI:

Step 1: Contact us at - stephan.stephan.cloete@gmail.com

Step 2: We will forward you a document to complete which will indicate to us your specific needs, what you would like to hunt and when you would like to hunt.

Step 3: Complete the document and return to us.

Step 4: We will draft a quotation based on your requirements and forward it to you.

Step 5: You indicate to us if the quotation is acceptable.

Step 6: We forward you a contract to sign setting out the prices and what is all included in the Safari.

Step 7: You sign the contract and return it to us.

Step 8: You pay the required 50% deposit to book your Safari.

Step 9: The final 50% on the daily rate is paid 60 days prior to your arrival.
